Fr. William Fitzgerald, O.Praem entered the Irish Canonry of the Order of Canons Regular of Prémontré (Norbertines) in 1972 and professed Solemn Vows in 1978. After completing the Licentiate in Theology at Rome's Pontifical University of St. Thomas (the Angelicum) in 1991 and serving as a High School Chaplain and Seminary Professor, Fr. William came to the United States and joined St. Michael's Abbey in Orange County, CA. Since coming to the U.S., Father Fitzgerald has served as Professor of Theology at Aquinas College, Director and Professor of Liturgy and Homiletics at the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio, Director of Liturgy for the Diocese of Covington, KY, and since 2007 as Associate Chaplain at Christendom College, Front Royal, VA.
